NOTIFICATION

- G.S.R....... (E). In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) Non-Technical Posts Recruitment Rules, 2017 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) Non-Technical Posts in the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, in the Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institutes, namely:-
- 1. **Short title and commencement.** (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) Non-Technical Posts Recruitment Rules, 2024.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Application.** These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** The number of thesaid posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 5. **Disqualification.** No person-
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. **Power to relax.** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard

Accountant in level-5 (Rs.29200-92300) in the pay matrix with six years of regular service in the level failing which Accountant with ten years combined regular service as Accountant in level-5(Rs.29200-92300) in the pay matrix and Upper Division Clerk in level-4 (Rs.25500-81100) in the pay matrix failing which Upper Division Clerk in level-4(Rs.25500-81100) in the pay matrix with ten years regular service in the level;

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Senior Hindi Typist in level-4(Rs.25500-81100) in the pay matrix with ten years regular service in the level and have successfully completed two to four weeks' training in Establishment or Accounts in Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration.

Note 1: Eligibility list for Upper Division Clerk and Senior Hindi Typist for promotion shall be prepared with respect to the date of completion by the officers of the prescribed qualifying service in the respective level or post.

Note 2: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:

Officers of Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration:

- (A) (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
 - (ii) with six years' service in the level rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the level-5(Rs.29200-92300) in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; or
 - (iii) with ten years' service in the level rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the level-4(25500-81100) in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department;

and

(B) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience, namely:-

Essential:

(i) Degree in any discipline from a recognised University;

(ii) One year experience in administration and accounts.

Desirable:

One year experience of Computer application, Data processing and Net Working.

Note 1: the departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall be not eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2:Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily, not exceed three years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

- (ii) With six years service in the level rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in level-5(Rs.29200-92300) in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; or
- (iii) With ten years service in the level rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in level-4(Rs.25500-81100) in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department.

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall be not eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2:Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily, not exceed three years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 3: Officers of only the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration shall be eligible for absorption.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualifications regarding experience

are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
