NOTE: The F.P.D.C committee seated on 24th July 2024, addressed the current agricultural challenges arising from an extended dry spell. It is for almost 52 days. The committee deliberated group discussion on the significant impact of prolonged dry weather and the affect on farm production and productivity. It was concluded that, involvement of an external subject expert is necessary. in response to the office letter No: 17-01/2023-Farm, the Mandal Agriculture Officer (M.A.O) of Garldinne Mandal had visited the farm. The M.A.O reported that the crops of the Institute, Garldinne region, are in a dire state. Many crops have not germinated fully, the germination is not occurred properly and the germinated seedlings are weak and lack vitality.

NOTE: The DANA cyclone, which struck just before the harvesting stage, caused significant damage to crops. rains led to physical damage, including lodging and discoloration of grains, particularly in Jowar and Bajra. Jowar experienced noticeable discoloration, potentially compromising its quality and yield. The cyclone's timing worsened the situation, as it effect occurred from Dt: 19.10.2024 to 26.10.2024 and resulting in crop loss and a decline in overall productivity. This has had a direct impact on both the quantity and quality of the harvest, posing challenge for farm production.
